Connection of Sewage system to NWC main

The Post and Telecommunications Department invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for the connection of its present sewage system to the NWC main on South Camp Road, Kingston.

Bidding will be conducted in accordance with the current guidelines stipulated in the Government of Jamaica Handbook of Public Sector Procurement Procedures.

Eligibility Criteria:

Bidders must submit the following documentation along with their bids:

- Copy of a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC);
- Copy of a valid National Contract Commission (NCC) registration certificate in the category of Civil Engineering Works, Building Construction or Building Maintenance grades 3-4
- A completed, signed Bid Submission Form;
- Price auotation

Failure to submit the above stipulated documents will result in the automatic disqualification of the bid.
