Jamaica Post Expands Outbound Mail Services To The United States With 15 Additional Locations

Kingston, Jamaica, June 30, 2026 - The Post and Telecommunications Department (Jamaica Post) is pleased to advise the public that effective **July 1, 2026**, the number of post offices accepting outbound parcels and packets (merchandise) destined for the United States will increase from forty (40) to fifty-five (55) locations islandwide.

This expansion follows the successful resumption of the service at the initial 40 locations and supports Jamaica Post's ongoing efforts to improve accessibility and convenience for customers while strengthening operational capacity.

While Jamaica Post continues to work toward the full restoration of outbound merchandise services, the service will now be available at the post offices listed below.

Customers are also reminded that merchandise valued under US\$800 and destined for the United States now requires the prepayment of duties using the approved Zonos Prepay mobile application prior to mailing their items. Accordingly, the following steps must be completed before visiting the post office:

1. Download the Zonos Prepay mobile app
2. Create a free account on the mobile app
3. Enter shipment details and prepay duties
4. Present the generated Declaration ID at the post office when mailing the package

Please note the following guidelines:

- Each package requires its own Declaration ID
- Shipments without a valid Declaration ID will not be accepted for mailing
- Documents (letters) to the United States remain unaffected and do not require use of the Zonos Prepay mobile app

Further updates will be communicated as progress continues. Jamaica Post thanks its customers for their continued patience and understanding and reaffirms its commitment to delivering reliable and efficient postal services.
