2 Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 at Cross Roads Post Office

The Post and Telecommunications Department wishes to advise that two of its employees have tested positive for COVID-19 at the Cross Roads Post Office, 100 Slipe Road, Kingston 5, Jamaica. The employees are currently in quarantine.

Under the guidance of the Ministry of Health and Wellness (MoHW) and out of an abundance of caution, the Department has taken the decision to close the Cross Roads Post Office for deep cleaning and sanitization effective Tuesday, October 06, 2020. The location will be reopened for regular business on Wednesday, October 7, 2020, from 7 am – 5 pm. In the interim, customers may visit any of our other locations to carry out their transactions. In keeping with the established protocols, the Department continues to sensitize and encourage team members and customers to observe the safety guidelines as set out by the MoHW and by extension the Government of Jamaica, such as wearing of face masks/ face shields and other personal protective equipment appropriately, washing hands with soap and water, using hand sanitizers frequently and maintaining social distance of at least 6 feet from others.
