## Staying safe & Outlasting Tropical Storm Elsa

As Tropical Storm Elsa continues to produce widespread rainfall and flash flooding across the island, the Post and Telecommunications Department (PTD) and the Postal Corporation of Jamaica (Post Corp) wishes for everyone to remain safe.

The Meteorological Services Division, Bulletin No.:19 has advised that "Weather Conditions over Jamaica, especially over eastern and central parishes, continue to be impacted by the heavy shower and thunderstorm associated with Tropical Storm Elsa. Rainfall will continue to spread across the island this morning while the tropical storm remains close to the island. Flash flooding will occur in low-lying and flood-prone areas today with 75-150 millimetres (3-6 inches) of rainfall in the forecast. Strong gusty winds are also expected during at least the next 6-12 hours."

We encourage persons to stay inside their homes; however, for persons who are in low-lying or flood-prone areas efforts are to be made to move to higher grounds and seek shelter where it's safe.
