Progress Update: Temporary Relocation of Negril Post Office to the Little London Post Office, Westmoreland

Kingston, Jamaica, October 4, 2024 - Jamaica Post acknowledges the challenges residents of Negril have faced since the temporary relocation of the Negril Post Office, located on West End Road, to the Little London Post Office. We further recognise that the distance between Negril and Little London has caused inconvenience to many of our customers.

As a part of an ongoing assessment of its facilities, Jamaica Post became aware of the deteriorating condition of the Negril Post Office building. In an effort to safeguard both our employees and the public and deliver service in a sound environment, we initiated a search for a temporary facility within Negril. Despite our best efforts, we have been unable to secure a suitable location within the town. Given the rapid worsening of the building's structure, a structural engineer was contracted to assess the structure and concluded that the facility was unsafe for use.

This expert assessment served as the basis of the decision to temporarily close the Negril Post Office and move operations to Little London while renovations are underway. The Negril location was closed effective July 23, 2024. In addition to prior notices, a reminder was shared via press release on July 25, 2024.

"We are actively working on multiple fronts to resolve this situation. The procurement process for repairs to the Negril Post Office has already begun, and we are expediting every possible step to ensure the restoration of services as soon as possible within the coming months. Additionally, our search for a suitable interim location closer to Negril continues." - Postmaster General, Lincoln Allen

Jamaica Post wishes to reiterate that all postal services will be available at the Little London Post Office.

Jamaica Post remains committed to serving the people of Negril with the highest level of service, and we truly regret the inconvenience caused during this transitory period.
