## **Progress Update: Negril Post Office, Westmoreland**

Kingston, Jamaica, May 22, 2025 - Jamaica Post takes this opportunity to inform our valued stakeholders about the progress relating to the Negril Post Office, located on West End Road, Negril, Westmoreland, following its temporary relocation of its operations to the Little London Post Office in Little London, Westmoreland.

As previously reported, this interim arrangement was necessary due to the deteriorating condition of the original Negril Post Office building. The decision for this relocation is in keeping with our ongoing commitment in ensuring a safe and secure environment for both our staff and valued customers as we work to renovate the affected structure. Jamaica Post is aware that many of our customers have been impacted by the distance between Negril and Little London and we sincerely regret the inconvenience that this has caused.

To address this issue and expedite the return of postal operations to the town of Negril, Jamaica Post, through the kind assistance of the Negril Chamber of Commerce, has identified a suitable location at the Negril Marine Park Headquarters building, located at Norman Manley Boulevard, Negril, Westmoreland. We are currently in discussions with the National Land Agency (NLA) to finalize arrangements to facilitate our timely occupancy of the space. We are optimistic that the negotiations will be favourable, enabling the resumption of postal operations to the town of Negril in the next three (3) months (July 2025).

In the interim, rehabilitation works on the original post office building are actively being pursued. Miss Tanickea Bennett, Public Relations Officer, has assured stakeholders that "we are working concurrently to implement a permanent solution with our efforts to rehabilitate the Negril Post Office building. We are now in the final stages of the procurement process." She further explained that "we are awaiting the requisite approvals and permits from the relevant authorities in order to commence the renovation of the Negril Post Office."

Customers are being reminded that all postal services for the residents of Negril remain available at the Little London Post Office. Additionally, for information about postal services and products, customers are encouraged to visit www.jamaicapost.gov.jm or email info@jamaicapost.gov.jm.

Jamaica Post thanks our valued stakeholders for their patience and understanding during this period of transformation and we commit to continue working with the Negril community to restore full postal service to the town of Negril.
