Old Jamaican Bank Notes Will Not Be Accepted After July 1, 2025

Jamaica Post advises that effective July 1, 2025, the old cotton banknotes will not be accepted for cash transactions at post offices islandwide, as they will no longer be legal tender. This is in keeping with the Bank of Jamaica's (BOJ) announcement of the demonetization of the old cotton banknotes comprised of the \$5000, \$1000, \$500, \$100 and \$50 denominations, effective the same date.

As a result of this update, cash transactions may be conducted using the new and approved polymer banknotes, which include the the \$5000, \$2000, \$1000, \$500 \$100, and \$50 denominations, that have been in circulation since June 2023, and the existing coin denominations of \$20, \$10, \$5 and \$1.
